KEY FINDINGS How has stroke care quality been maintained after the pandemic? Apr-Jun21 vs Apr-Jun22

The proportion of patients directly admitted to a stroke unit within 4 hours of clock start was 38.3% in Jan-Mar22, a decrease of 11.2% compared to Jan-Mar21 (49.5%).

Onset to arrival time is currently 3h47m, an increase from 3h29m in AprJun21 and 3h17m in AprJun20.

The proportion of patients scanned within 1 hour of arrival and the median time between arrival and brain scan remain steady, with 56.1% scanned within 1 hour in AprJun22 (compared to 55.9% in AprJun21).

The median time between arrival and assessment by a stroke nurse continues to fall, currently at 42 minutes compared to 47 minutes in AprJun21.
