

KEY FINDINGS How has stroke care quality been maintained during the pandemic? Jan-Mar21 vs Jan-Mar22



-11.2%

The proportion of patients directly admitted to a stroke unit within 4 hours of clock start was 38.3% in Jan-Mar22, a decrease of 11.2% compared to Jan-Mar21 (49.5%).

The median time between clock start and being assessed by a stroke consultant was 1 hour and 8 minutes higher in Jan-Mar22 (9h 53min) than in Jan-Mar21 (8h 45min).

The median time between clock start and thrombolysis has remained under 1 hour when comparing both periods, having been 52 minutes for Jan-Mar22, 2 minutes less than in Jan-Mar21.

The proportion of patients treated by a stroke skilled Early Supported Discharge team has remained stable, having been 47.3% in Jan-Mar22, and 47.2% in Jan-Mar21.
