### KEY FINDINGS: HOW HAS STROKE CARE QUALITY BEEN MAINTAINED DURING THE PANDEMIC?

Jul-Sep 19 vs Jul-Sep 20



**+1%**

The percentage of patients scanned within 1 hour of clock start has been 56% during Jul-Sep20, a 1% increase compared to same period 2019.



**+2%**

The percentage of patients directly admitted to a stroke unit within 4 hours of clock start was 59% during Jul-Sep20, a 2% increase compared to same period 2019.



**-1hr**

The median time between clock start and being assessed by stroke consultant (hours:mins) was 8:26 during Jul-Sep20, more than one hour less than the 9:35 captured in the previous year.



**=**

The percentage of patients who spent at least 90% of their stay on stroke unit has remained stable at 84%.
